- **Ball catering.** The school ball committee has asked if the PTA might like to use this as a fundraising opportunity. Maree to investigate. (Purchased bulk of food, which is now stored in the tuck shop freezer).

- **Ball Gowns.** An offer has been made to loan out a couple of gowns for any girl who can't afford one, although choice of size may be an issue. If any student is seen struggling financially to afford a ticket, a gown or suit, makeup etc, Bev is to approach the PTA for help. Maree to approach Kris Orr re make up...
- **PTA Fundraiser.** Sausage sizzle to be held on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March. Funds raised will be used to help groups who may need financial assistance. Bev has notified students of the event through the newsletter already. Yvonne, Shaz, Maree and Vinnie to be at the school at 12noon to set up. Shaz to organise the food.
- **PTA Members.** A suggestion was made that perhaps we could attract more parents by rebranding the name. Recommendations have been made for *Friends & Family of BB College* and *PIE* (Parent Information Evenings). The decision was made to leave as PTA for the present. Yvonne suggested that advertising PTA dates in the Upcoming Events Columns in the local papers like the Bream Bay News and the Mangawhai Focus might help remind parents.
- **Allocation of PTA Funds.** \$180.00 has been given to 18 dance students to help subsidise their dance trip. \$300.00 has been offered to help get students to a Leadership workshop. \$100.00 has been promised to cover the shortfall of Year 9 Camp Fees. Other groups like the boys' football team going to Tournament Week and the hockey team to the AIMS Games, have also requested assistance. Students receiving support will be asked to help out at some of our fundraising events.
- **Star Awards.** Teachers have been issuing good behaviour notes to students (Bronze/Silver/Gold) with the incentive of winning prizes. Behaviour throughout the school this term appears to have improved, and because of the success the scheme, the PTA have offered \$100.00 per term to purchase prizes, and to help with a major prize at the end of the year, IF the student council match the offer.
